COMING TO FIC



Do not come to FIC

- If you experience one or more of the following **symptoms**: fever, headaches, cough, aches, unusual fatigue, breathing difficulty, loss of taste and/or smell
- If you have been in **contact with a person carrying COVID-19**



Be sure to print your badge before your visit!

- To **avoid contacts**
- To **facilitate access** and reduce waiting times



Face Masks - Compulsory

- **Disposable masks** available if needed at the reception desk

Health pass

- **Required** to access to the FIC 2021

The health pass consists of the digital or paper version of one of the following documents which must include the 2D-DOC code:

- a full vaccination certificate
- a **negative RT-PCR or antigenic test result** of less than 72 h
- a **certificate of recovery** from COVID-19
- antigenic tests available from 7:30 am to 12:30 pm on the forecourt of Lille Grand Palais

BARRIER MEASURES



Wearing a face mask is compulsory for all and at all times during the FIC



Hand hygiene

- **Wash your hands** regularly with soap and water
- **Hydroalcolic solution** available in several areas of the Fair, outside all conference rooms, and on the stands



Ensure social distancing everywhere onsite

- Maintain **social distances** (min. 1m / 3 ft.) between participants in waiting lines (entrance, reception desks, catering area, lavatory)
- **Recommended one-way traffic** direction and clear floor markings within the event
- **Separate entrance** and exit points



Catering

- Keep a **self distance from others** in the catering area (at least 1m / 3 ft.)
- Indoor cocktails allowed



Avoiding close contacts with others

- **No handshakes or hugs** when greeting people



Cough or sneeze into your elbow or into a disposable tissue



Use paper tissues only and dispose of them immediately after use

HYGIENE & INFECTION PREVENTION



Lavatory

- A dedicated team will continuously **ensure the cleanliness and disinfection** of common areas and lavatory, and the frequent restocking of bathroom consumables (soap, paper towels)
- **Hand dryers disabled**



Hydroalcolic solution dispensers provided in several points

- **Common areas** : entrance and exit points; at the top of the escalators and the stairs
- **At reception**; outside conference rooms and auditoriums; in several areas of the Fair



Cleaning of common areas

- COVID-Busters team: **intensified cleaning and disinfection** of all surfaces and touch points (stair railings, door knobs, switches, elevator boutons, public facilities etc.)
- **Special waste containers** installed at exit points to discard disposable face masks after use



Cleaning of audiovisual materials

- **Cleaning and disinfection of all audiovisual materials between each intervention** (pointers, remote controls, keyboards, computer mouses etc.)
- **One microphone per speaker** ; each microphone will be equipped with disposable foam protections



Air conditioning system

- **100% fresh air supply**

PUBLIC SAFETY



Health pass - Compulsory

- **Control of the health pass** on the forecourt before entering Lille Grand Palais



Communication Management

- In case of probable or confirmed COVID-19 patients: **local health authorities will handle overall communication to and follow-up of all potential contact cases**
- **Identification and traceability of the chain** of infection, in coordination with the Hauts-de-France Regional Health Agency



Management of suspect COVID-19 cases

- An **isolation room** dedicated and equipped to manage suspect COVID-19 cases
- **COVID-19 dedicated personnel**, following the sanitary protocol in force and authorities' guidance
- All patients showing any severe symptoms will be **taken care of by the French SAMU** (emergency health and assistance services)

Sanitary measures implemented during the International Cybersecurity Forum (FIC), in accordance with Lille Grand Palais Health Protocol.

These measures are subject to change depending on government announcements.
